RAFFLE COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. INTRODUCTION

- (a) This competition (**Competition**) is conducted by Iron Horse Productions in association with Perry (**the Organisers**).
- (b) Any person who enters the competition (the Participant) acknowledges that the terms and conditions set out herein are binding on them.

2. RULES OF THE COMPETITION

- (a) The Competition is a raffle. Entrants buy tickets for a chance to win a 2026 KTM 300 TBI motorcycle.
- (b) Each valid ticket equals one entry into the draw.
- (c) Ticket prices are:
 - (i) 1 ticket: R1 000
 - (ii) 2 tickets: R2 000
 - (iii) 3 tickets: R2 700
 - (iv) 4 tickets: R3 500
 - (v) 5 tickets or more: R800 per ticket
- (d) There shall be a maximum of 20 tickets per entrant.
- (e) Entries close at 11:59pm on Friday, 27 March 2026, or when the 250th entrant enters the Competition.
- (f) The draw will take place on Saturday, 28 March 2026 during prizegiving at Round 2 of the Iron Horse Funduro Series (venue to be announced).
- (g) The winner of the draw does not need to be present at the draw.
- (h) An entry is only valid if:
 - (i) payment has cleared into the Iron Horse Productions bank account;
 - (ii) proof of payment is emailed to ihproduct111@gmail.com with payment reference "KTM + your Name/Surname".

3. MINIMUM ENTRIES AND CANCELLATION OF COMPETITION

- (a) If fewer than 200 tickets are sold:
 - (i) no draw will be held;
 - (ii) the Competition will be cancelled; and
 - (iii) all ticket payments will be refunded in full.
- (b) No further claims may be made against the Organisers in the event that the Competition is cancelled.
- (c) In any event, the Organisers may, at their discretion, cancel the Competition for any reason they see fit, in which case, any ticket entries will be refunded to the relevant entrant.

4. LIABILITY

- (a) Entrants participate in the Competition at their own risk.
- (b) The Organisers are not liable for any loss or damage arising from participating or from acceptance or use of any prize, except where liability cannot be excluded by law.
